




2020/01/01 - 2020/12/31 Emissions Intensity by Scope

Emission breakdown by scope as a share of total emissions reported










The breakdown below indicates the emissions intensity by different sources reported and categorized by relevant scope. Each source of emissions has been normalized by employee and million units of revenue.





Emissions Intensity by Scope Over Time

Emissions Reductions Over Time




